At our last meeting we mentioned that we had arranged a meeting with [redacted] and [redacted] of the LEP. We had that meeting today and it was extremely positive.

We reassured them that there will certainly be an element of employment land as part of a mixed use scheme and that our current thinking is that it would be at the A38 end of the site.

This would fit well as part of an Enterprise Area focusing on Advanced Manufacturing which could include Airbus and Rolls Royce. This cluster would then be used to promote inward investment.

I understand that they are meeting with [redacted] S-Glos Chief Exec. shortly and may well raise this idea.
